AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 191

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and V. Turner” and substitute “V. Turner, Anderson, G. Clagett, DeBoy, Healey, Heller, Hixson, Hubbard, Kelley, Mandel, Murray, Parker, Parrott, Petzold, Sophocleus, Stern, and Vallario”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 5, strike “Senate co-chairman and House co-chairman” and substitute “chairman”; in line 9, after the first “certain” insert “interim”; in the same line, after “date;” insert “requiring a certain final report on or before a certain date;”; and strike in their entirety lines 11 through 21, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 7, insert:

“(6) the Motor Vehicle Administrator, or the Administrator’s designee;”;

in line 8, strike “(6)” and substitute “(7)”; strike in their entirety lines 11 through 19, inclusive, and substitute:

“(ii) two representatives of the local law enforcement community;

“(iii) three representatives of the banking or credit card industry;

“(iv) one representative of the Maryland Retailers’ Association;”;

in line 20, strike “(iii)” and substitute “(v)”; in line 21, strike “(iv)” and substitute “(vi)”; strike lines 23 and 24 in their entirety and substitute:

(Over)

“(vii) one representative from the Technology Council of Maryland.”;

in line 25, strike “(1)”; in the same line, strike “President of the Senate” and substitute “Governor”; strike beginning with “one” in line 25 down through “co-chairman” in line 26 and substitute “the chairman”; strike lines 27 and 28 in their entirety; and in line 29, strike “Legislative Services” and substitute “Labor, Licensing and Regulation”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, strike beginning with “law” in line 7 down through “detering” in line 8 and substitute “criminal and civil laws for deterring, investigating, and prosecuting”; in line 8, strike “and”; after line 10, insert:

“(iii) ways of educating the public about identity theft; and

(iv) the effectiveness of government policies and practices in deterring and reducing identity theft;”;

in line 16, strike “remedies to” and substitute “solutions to the problem of”; in the same line, after “theft,” insert “addressing each of the study items listed in paragraph (1) of this subsection,”; strike beginning with “report” in line 18 down through “2005” in line 19 and substitute “;

(1) submit an interim report to the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2004; and

(2) submit a final report including the findings and recommendations of the Task Force to the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2005”.
