AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1351

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and V. Turner” and substitute “V. Turner, Boteler, Boutin, Bromwell, Donoghue, Elliott, Goldwater, Hammen, Hubbard, Hurson, Kach, Mandel, McDonough, Morhaim, Pendergrass, Rudolph, Smigiel, and Weldon”; in line 2, strike “Mental Hygiene Administration” and substitute “Department of Health and Mental Hygiene”; in line 5, after the first comma insert “closed,”; in line 7, after the semicolon insert “providing that a cemetery or an easement or right of entry to a cemetery owned by the State and located on the grounds of a State facility may be sold under certain circumstances; defining a certain term;”; and strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY adding to

Article - State Finance and Procurement

Section 10-309

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2001 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 16 and 17 and substitute:

“Article - State Finance and Procurement

10-309.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, “STATE FACILITY” MEANS:

(1) A FACILITY MAINTAINED BY THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE AND

(Over)

LISTED IN § 10-406 OF THE HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE; OR

(2) A STATE RESIDENTIAL CENTER FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH MENTAL RETARDATION IN THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.”;

in lines 18, 21, and 24, strike “(A)”, “(B)”, and “(C)”, respectively, and substitute “(B)”, “(C)”, and “(D)”, respectively; in line 20, after the second comma insert “CLOSED.”; and after line 27, insert:

“(E) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, A CEMETERY OR AN EASEMENT OR RIGHT OF ENTRY TO A CEMETERY OWNED BY THE STATE AND LOCATED ON THE GROUNDS OF A STATE FACILITY MAY BE SOLD BY THE STATE IF THE DEED FOR THE PROPERTY INCLUDES A RESTRICTIVE COVENANT REQUIRING THE OWNER AND ANY FUTURE OWNER TO MAINTAIN THE CEMETERY AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.”.
