AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 671

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 2, strike “Right” and substitute “Authorization”; in the same line, after “Seafood” insert “and Engage in the Seafood Industry”; in lines 4 and 5, and 7 and 8, in each instance, strike “protect a person’s right” and substitute “authorize a person to engage in certain activities related to the seafood industry and”; and in line 6, after the semicolon insert “providing that in the event of a certain conflict, federal law, State law, or a certain written program guidance preempts a certain ordinance, resolution, or regulation;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In line 21, strike “PROTECT A PERSON’S RIGHT” and substitute “AUTHORIZE A PERSON”; in the same line, after the second “TO” insert “:

(1) USE THE PERSON’S PERSONAL PROPERTY OR REAL ESTATE TO OPERATE A SEAFOOD BUSINESS;

(2) BUY OR SELL SEAFOOD;

(3) STORE EQUIPMENT USED IN THE PERSON’S SEAFOOD BUSINESS;

(4) ENJOY THE QUIET CONDUCT OF THE PERSON’S SEAFOOD BUSINESS IN CONFORMANCE WITH COUNTY AND STATE REQUIREMENTS; AND

(5)”;

and after line 24, insert:

“(C) IN THE EVENT OF A CONFLICT, FEDERAL LAW, STATE LAW, OR

(Over)

WRITTEN PROGRAM GUIDANCE ISSUED BY A FEDERAL OR STATE AGENCY SHALL PREEMPT ANY ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, OR REGULATION ADOPTED OR ANY ACTION TAKEN BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL UNDER THIS SECTION.”.
