AMENDMENT NO. 2

In line 21, strike "PROTECT A PERSON'S RIGHT" and substitute "<u>AUTHORIZE A</u> <u>PERSON</u>"; in the same line, after the second "TO" insert "<u>:</u>

(1) USE THE PERSON'S PERSONAL PROPERTY OR REAL ESTATE TO OPERATE A SEAFOOD BUSINESS;

- (2) BUY OR SELL SEAFOOD;
- (3) STORE EQUIPMENT USED IN THE PERSON'S SEAFOOD BUSINESS;

(4) ENJOY THE QUIET CONDUCT OF THE PERSON'S SEAFOOD BUSINESS IN CONFORMANCE WITH COUNTY AND STATE REQUIREMENTS; AND

<u>(5)</u>";

and after line 24, insert:

"(C) IN THE EVENT OF A CONFLICT, FEDERAL LAW, STATE LAW, OR
