AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 622, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On pages 1 and 2 of the Appropriations Committee Amendments (HB0622/124360/1), strike in their entirety Amendments Nos. 1, 2, and 4.

On page 1 of the bill, in line 2, strike the second “Public”; in line 3, strike “Hearing Process” and substitute “Comment”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 4 down through “appropriations;” in line 6 and substitute “altering the circumstances under which the Governor may reduce certain appropriations;”; and strike beginning with “requiring” in line 8 down through “appropriations;” in line 12.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the bill, in line 1, strike “considers unnecessary” and substitute “FINDS AND DECLARES IS NECESSARY TO BE REDUCED IN ORDER TO AVOID A DEFICIT IN THE FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH THE APPROPRIATION IS MADE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1 of the Appropriations Committee Amendments, in line 2 of Amendment No. 3, strike “21-DAY” and substitute “7-DAY”; and in the same line, strike “10”.

On page 2 of the bill, in line 14, strike “(1)”; strike beginning with the colon in line 15 down through “(I)” in line 16; in line 16, strike “PUBLIC”; and strike beginning with “; AND” in line 19 down through “APPROPRIATIONS” in line 23.

On pages 2 and 3 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 24 on page 2 through line 3 on page 3, inclusive.
