AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 494, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (HB0494/634138/1), in Amendment No. 1, strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 2 down through “penalties;” in line 4 and substitute “requiring the Department of the Environment to provide a certain notice and opportunity for a certain meeting to a certain person prior to taking a certain action against the person for an alleged violation of tidal wetlands provisions;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments, in Amendment No. 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 7 on page 1 through line 21 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

“(C) BEFORE TAKING ANY CIVIL ACTION TO RECOVER A PENALTY UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE PERSON ALLEGED TO HAVE VIOLATED THIS TITLE WITH WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED PENALTY AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR AN INFORMAL MEETING CONCERNING SETTLEMENT OF THE PROPOSED CIVIL ACTION.”.
