On page 6, in line 22, strike "AN APPROVED" and substitute "<u>A TRAINING PROGRAM FROM A</u>"; in line 23, strike "AS DEFINED IN § 3-201(A)" and substitute "<u>APPROVED BY THE POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 3, SUBTITLE 2</u>"; in line 28, after "SUBTITLE" insert ":

- (1) WHILE OPERATING IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY; AND
- (2) WHILE OPERATING OUTSIDE MONTGOMERY COUNTY WHEN:
- (I) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY FIRE AND EXPLOSIVE INVESTIGATOR IS PARTICIPATING IN A JOINT INVESTIGATION WITH OFFICIALS FROM ANOTHER STATE, FEDERAL, OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT, AT LEAST ONE OF WHICH HAS LOCAL JURISDICTION;
- (II) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY FIRE AND EXPLOSIVE INVESTIGATOR IS RENDERING ASSISTANCE TO ANOTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER;
