AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 884, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In the Economic Matters Committee Amendments (HB0884/523095/1), strike Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 in their entirety.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 of the bill, strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "State Board of Docking Masters - Tug Assistance - Rotating Schedule"; strike beginning with "transferring" in line 3 down through "and" in line 14 and substitute "requiring the State Board of Docking Masters to require docking masters to use a rotating schedule to call for the assistance of an additional tug in the maneuvering of a vessel; requiring the Board to adopt regulations to implement certain provisions of law; and generally relating to the use of a rotating schedule for tug assistance by"; and after line 14, insert:

"BY adding to

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

Section 5.5-208

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2000 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

5.5-208.

(A) IF A DOCKING MASTER NEEDS ADDITIONAL TUG ASSISTANCE IN THE

(Over)

MANEUVERING OF A VESSEL, THE DOCKING MASTER SHALL USE A ROTATING SCHEDULE TO CALL FOR THE ADDITIONAL TUG.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 1 through 12 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 1 through line 8 on page 12, inclusive.
