AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1094

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Registrable” and substitute “Subsequent”; in line 3, strike “altering the” and substitute “establishing a”; strike beginning with “is” in line 4 down through “crime” in line 5 and substitute “has previously committed a certain offense not arising out of the same incident”; and strike in their entirety lines 11 through 15, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “AN” in line 8 down through “CONVICTION” in line 11 and substitute “(I) ON CONVICTION OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED ON A PRIOR OCCASION NOT ARISING FROM THE SAME INCIDENT OF A VIOLATION OF §§ 3-303 THROUGH 3-312 OR § 3-315 OF THIS SUBTITLE OR § 3-602 OF THIS TITLE”; and after line 12, insert:

“(II) IF THE STATE INTENDS TO PROCEED AGAINST A PERSON UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IT SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROCEDURES SET FORTH IN THE MARYLAND RULES FOR THE INDICTMENT AND TRIAL OF A SUBSEQUENT OFFENDER.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 2 through 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 13 on page 2 through line 21 on page 4, inclusive.
