### AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1354

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after "members;" insert "<u>eliminating the position of full-time Executive Director of the Council;</u>"; in the same line, strike "providing for" and substitute "<u>extending</u>"; in the same line, strike "of this Act" and substitute "<u>date of the Advisory Council until a certain date</u>"; in line 12, strike "2-301 and"; in line 17, after "Section" insert "<u>2-301,</u>"; in the same line, strike "and 2-304" and substitute "<u>, 2-304, and 2-305</u>"; and after line 19, insert:

# "BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

<u>Chapter 687 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001</u> Section 2".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 1 and 2; and in lines 3 and 9, strike "(d)" and "(e)", respectively, and substitute "(C)" and "(D)", respectively.

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike beginning with the colon in line 16 down through "(2)" in line 18; and after line 18, insert:

"2-305.

## The Council shall[:

- (1)] gather information[,] AND solicit ideas[, and advise and provide guidance to the Executive Director] on ways to:
  - [(i)] (1) develop transitional supports and expand employment

opportunities for offenders both in institutional and community settings;

- [(ii)] (2) provide more extensive employment counseling for offenders under correctional control;
- [(iii)] (3) transfer successful institutional programs and services that prepare offenders for employment and provide employment opportunities to community settings;
- [(iv)] (4) increase job placement and job retention rates for all offenders under correctional control;
- [(v)] (5) improve the overall coordination of employment services for offenders;
  - [(vi)] (6) develop and implement a business mentoring program; and
  - [(vii)] (7) conduct mock job fairs in institutions and in the community[;

<u>and</u>

(2) assist the Executive Director in the development of a plan for transitional employment that incorporates the objectives stated in item (1) of this section].

## Chapter 687 of the Acts of 2001

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of [3] 6 years and 3 months and, at the end of August 31, [2004] 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.";

and strike beginning with "It" in line 20 down through "effect." in line 22.
