AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 554

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "License" and substitute "Permit"; in lines 4, 6, 7, and 11, in each instance, strike "license" and substitute "permit"; in line 6, after the semicolon insert "prohibiting a certain recreational angler from possessing a certain species of fish;"; in line 8, strike "certain funds" and substitute "a certain fund"; and in line 10, after "changes;" insert "providing for the termination of this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 in lines 16, 22, 24, and 28, and on page 3 in lines 3, 12, 13, 14, and 17, in each instance, strike "LICENSE" and substitute "PERMIT".

On page 3, after line 2, insert:

"(D) A RECREATIONAL ANGLER UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF A COASTAL BAYS FISHING GUIDE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT POSSESS THE SPECIES OF FISH KNOWN AS STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH.";

in lines 3, 12, 19, and 27, strike "(D)", "(E)", "(F)", and "(G)", respectively, and substitute "(E)", "(F)", "(G)", and "(H)", respectively; in line 13, in each instance, strike "LICENSEE" and substitute "PERMIT HOLDER"; in line 18, strike "(D)(2)" and substitute "(E)(2)"; in line 20, strike "EQUALLY"; and strike beginning with "FISHERIES" in line 20 down through "THE" in line 21.

On page 4, in lines 2, 3, and 6, in each instance, strike "LICENSES" and substitute "PERMITS".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 1, strike “30” and substitute “25”; and in line 9, after the period insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and 3 months and, at the end of August 31, 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
