AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 735

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Marriott” and substitute “Marriott, Barve, Cardin, and Heller”; in line 2, strike “- Deadline”; in line 4, strike “the deadline to change” and substitute “voters’ change of”; in the same line, after the semicolon insert “altering the provision of law concerning the time period for the submission of a certain voter registration report to the State Board of Elections to require a local board of elections to submit the report to the State Board when it is directed to do so by the State Board;”; and in line 7, after “3-303” insert “and 3-509(a)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 16, insert:

“3-509.

(a) [Within 15 days after the commencement of the period under § 3-303(a) of this title in which registered voters are not allowed to change party affiliation or change to or from a decline, and at other times as] WHEN directed by the State Board, each local board shall submit to the State Board a report of registration setting forth the following information, as shown on the registry of the respective local board as of the date of the commencement of the period:

(1) the name of each political party with which one or more registered voters in their respective jurisdiction are then affiliated; and

(2) the total number of registered voters affiliated with each such political party.”.
