AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 676, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of Senator Colburn's Amendments (SB0676/813824/1), in line 1 of Amendment No. 1, strike "37th District -"; in line 1 of Amendment No. 1, after "Straw Ballots" insert "- Voter Opinions - Various Counties"; in line 5 of Amendment No. 1, after "ballot;" insert "requiring that a question be placed on the ballot in Prince George's County at the November general election of 2004 to determine the sense of the voters of the County on the issue of locating video lottery terminals licensed by the State for commercial gaming purposes in Prince George's County; providing for the carrying out of the straw ballot;"; and in line 7 of Amendment No. 1, after "District" insert "and Prince George's County".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of Senator Colburn's Amendments, in line 7 of Amendment No. 2, after "only." insert:

"SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) Under the provisions of the Election Law Article, the Prince George's County Board of Elections, in consultation with the State Board of Elections, shall prepare and include on the ballot for the November general election of 2004 the following question:

"Do you support locating video lottery terminals licensed by the State for commercial gaming purposes in Prince George's County?".

(b) The Prince George's County Board of Elections and the County Council of Prince George's County shall do those things necessary and proper to place this question on the ballot prepared for the November general election of 2004, so that each participating voter in the County may have the opportunity to cast a vote on the question. The question shall be proposed, presented,

tallied, and reported in general accordance with the provisions of the Election Law Article. The vote on this question is advisory only.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

In line 24 of the bill, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”.
