AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 377

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

At the top of page 1, insert "EMERGENCY BILL"; in line 4, after "person" insert ", including a commercial entity,"; in line 5, after "system" insert ", except under certain circumstances"; and in the same line, after the semicolon insert "requiring a custodian to permit inspection of certain public records by certain persons; making this Act an emergency measure;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 23, after "(L)" insert "(1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,"; in line 24, after "PERSON" insert ", INCLUDING A COMMERCIAL ENTITY,"; after line 25, insert:

"(2) A CUSTODIAN SHALL PERMIT INSPECTION BY:

(I) THE PERSON IN INTEREST;

(II) AN ALARM OR SECURITY SYSTEM COMPANY IF THE COMPANY CAN DOCUMENT THAT IT CURRENTLY PROVIDES ALARM OR SECURITY SERVICES TO THE PERSON IN INTEREST;

(III) LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL; AND

(IV) EMERGENCY SERVICES PERSONNEL, INCLUDING:

1. A CAREER FIREFIGHTER;

2. AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER, AS DEFINED IN § 13-516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE;

(Over)

3. A RESCUE SQUAD EMPLOYEE; AND

4. A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER, RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER, OR ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT UNIT MEMBER.”;

and strike in their entirety lines 26 and 27 and substitute:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.”.
