### AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 708 (First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Weldon" and substitute "<u>Weldon, Benson, Boteler,</u> <u>Boutin, Costa, Elliott, Mandel, McDonough, Pendergrass, and V. Turner</u>"; in line 2, strike "Procurement" and substitute "<u>Proposed Capital Projects - Planning</u>"; in the same line, strike "- Price Preferences"; strike beginning with "establishing" in line 3 down through "preference" in line 9 and substitute "<u>requiring a unit of State government requesting an appropriation for the preliminary</u> planning of a proposed capital project to include in its program submission to the Department of <u>Budget and Management a justification for proposing that the building is not appropriate for design</u> <u>as a high performance building</u>"; in line 10, strike "making certain stylistic changes;"; strike beginning with "price" in line 10 down through "contracts" in line 12 and substitute "<u>the planning</u> <u>and design of high performance buildings in proposed capital projects</u>"; strike line 15 in its entirety and substitute "<u>Section 3-602(d)</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 18 through 22, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 through 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 2 on page 2 through line 5 on page 5, inclusive, and substitute:

## (d) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "HIGH PERFORMANCE BUILDING" MEANS A BUILDING THAT ACHIEVES AT LEAST:

# (I) <u>A SILVER RATING ACCORDING TO THE U.S. GREEN</u> <u>BUILDING COUNCIL'S LEED (LEADERSHIP IN ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL</u> <u>DESIGN) GREEN BUILDING RATING SYSTEM AS ADOPTED IN 2001 BY THE</u> <u>MARYLAND GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL; OR</u>

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## (II) <u>A COMPARABLE NUMERIC RATING ACCORDING TO A</u> <u>NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED, ACCEPTED, AND APPROPRIATE NUMERIC SUSTAINABLE</u> <u>DEVELOPMENT RATING SYSTEM, GUIDELINE, OR STANDARD.</u>

[(1)] (2) Before an appropriation may be authorized for preliminary planning of a proposed capital project:

(i) the unit of the State government requesting the appropriation shall submit to the Department a program describing, in detail[,]:

1. the scope and purpose of the project; and

2. <u>THE JUSTIFICATION FOR PROPOSING THAT A</u> <u>BUILDING IN THE PROJECT IS NOT APPROPRIATE FOR DESIGN AS A HIGH</u> <u>PERFORMANCE BUILDING; AND</u>

(ii) the Secretary of Budget and Management must approve the program.

[(2)] (3) Before an appropriation may be authorized for construction of a proposed capital project:

(i) the unit of State government requesting the appropriation shall submit to the Departments of Budget and Management and General Services a detailed design program, which shall include all information required by the Departments; and

(ii) both the Secretary of Budget and Management and the Secretary of General Services must approve the detailed design program.".
