AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 718

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Zirkin” and substitute “Zirkin, Benson, Boteler, Boutin, Costa, Elliott, Mandel, McDonough, Pendergrass, and V. Turner”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 5 and 6; and in line 7, strike “(6)” and substitute “(5)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike beginning with “WHEN” in line 21 down through “CONTRACT” in line 33 and substitute:

“WHEN A UNIT USES COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSALS TO AWARD A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT, THE UNIT MAY GIVE A PREFERENCE TO RESIDENT OFFERORS IF:

(1) A RESPONSIBLE OFFEROR WHOSE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OR OPERATION IS IN ANOTHER STATE SUBMITS A PROPOSAL;

(2) THE STATE IN WHICH THE NONRESIDENT OFFEROR’S PRINCIPAL OFFICE IS LOCATED OR THE STATE IN WHICH THE NONRESIDENT OFFEROR HAS ITS PRINCIPAL OPERATION THROUGH WHICH IT WOULD PROVIDE THE SUBJECT OF THE CONTRACT GIVES A PREFERENCE TO ITS RESIDENTS; AND

(3) THE PREFERENCE DOES NOT CONFLICT WITH A FEDERAL LAW OR GRANT AFFECTING THE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT”.
