#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 9, after "issued;" insert "providing that only certain persons may erect and maintain stationary blinds or blind sites in certain counties;"; after line 10, insert:

#### "BY adding to

Article - Natural Resources Section 10-601.1 and 10-607(m) Annotated Code of Maryland (2000 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)";

and strike in their entirety lines 21 through 25, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 1, insert:

## "<u>10-601.1</u>

# THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.".

On page 3, in line 12, strike "shall [" and substitute "<u>MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR</u>"; in the same line, strike the second bracket and substitute "<u>OF THE STATE, BUT SHALL</u>"; and in line 17, strike "10-608" and substitute "<u>10-608(B) THROUGH (H)</u>".

On page 4, in line 14, strike "Kent County and Queen Anne's County" and substitute "<u>CAROLINE, DORCHESTER, KENT, QUEEN ANNE'S, AND TALBOT COUNTIES</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 21 and 22.
