AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "MEDICATION" in line 14 down through "BOARD" in line 15 and substitute "<u>AN INFLUENZA VACCINATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 12-508 OF</u> THIS TITLE".

On page 3, strike beginning with "MEDICATION" in line 1 down through "BOARD" in line 2 and substitute "<u>AN INFLUENZA VACCINATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 12-508 OF THIS</u> TITLE".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 2, insert:

"SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as

follows:

Article - Health Occupations

<u>12-508.</u>

- (A) A PHARMACIST MAY ADMINISTER AN INFLUENZA VACCINATION TO AN INDIVIDUAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- (B) THE BOARD SHALL SET REASONABLE FEES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF AN INFLUENZA VACCINATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION THAT ACCOUNT FOR THE COST OF THE VACCINATION AND A REASONABLE CHARGE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE VACCINATION.
- (C) THE BOARD, TOGETHER WITH THE BOARD OF PHYSICIANS AND THE BOARD OF NURSING, SHALL JOINTLY DEVELOP AND ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.";

and strike in their entirety lines 3 through 5, inclusive.
