AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "authorizing" in line 20 down through "manner;" in line 22; in line 25, strike "providing for certain funding for the corporation;"; and in line 30, after "severable;" insert "stating the intent that funding for the corporation must be provided within existing resources of certain State agencies and that additional funding may not be provided until certain conditions are met;".

On page 2, in line 2, strike "13-516" and substitute "<u>13-515</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 8, in line 16, after "INDUSTRIES" insert "OR AGRITOURISM".

On page 18, strike in their entirety lines 27 through 34, inclusive.

On page 19, in lines 1, 6, and 15, strike "13-512.", "13-513.", and "13-514.", respectively, and substitute "13-511.", "13-512.", and "13-513.", respectively; and in line 30, strike "SHALL" and substitute "MAY".

On page 20, in lines 18 and 27, strike "13-515." and "13-516.", respectively, and substitute "<u>13-514.</u>" and "<u>13-515.</u>", respectively.

On page 21, after line 1, insert:

"SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that State funding for the corporation should be provided within existing resources of the Departments of Agriculture, Budget and Management, Business and Economic Development, Environment, and Housing and Community Development and any other State agency determined to

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be appropriate by the Secretary of Budget and Management. Other than existing resources, additional funding may not be provided for the staffing, operations, or capital needs of the corporation until the State's fiscal crisis and structural deficit is resolved.";

and in lines 2 and 8, strike "3." and "4.", respectively, and substitute "4." and "5.", respectively.
