- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring that in-State undergraduate student enrollment at
- 5 certain institutions of the University System of Maryland be at least a certain

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "IN-STATE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT" MEANS A
- 21 STUDENT WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PAY RESIDENT TUITION AT AN INSTITUTION OF THE
- 22 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND.
- 23 (B) THE PROPORTION OF IN-STATE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS AT EACH
- 24 INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND, EXCLUDING THE
- 25 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, SHALL BE AT LEAST 75% OF ITS
- 26 TOTAL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT POPULATION.

- 1 (C) THE BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL ESTABLISH AN INCENTIVE PROGRAM TO
- $2\,$ ENCOURAGE INSTITUTIONS TO INCREASE IN-STATE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT
- $3\,$ ENROLLMENT TO 80% OF AN INSTITUTION'S TOTAL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT

- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2004.
