- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 17 (2) "Disabled public safety employee" means a State or local public safety
- 18 employee who sustains an injury in the line of duty that:
- 19 (i) Precludes the individual from continuing to serve or be
- 20 employed as a State or local public safety employee; and
- 21 (ii) In the case of a volunteer member of a fire department or
- 22 ambulance or rescue company or squad, precludes the member from continuing to be
- 23 employed in the nonpublic safety occupation in which the member is engaged at the
- 24 time of the injury.
- 25 "Surviving spouse" means a person who has not remarried.

Each recipient of a scholarship under this section may hold the award 4 for 5 years of full-time study or 8 years of part-time study. The Office may not award more than 15 scholarships annually under 6 subsection (d)(3)(v) of this section. 7 An award provided under subsection (d)(3)(vi) of this section may not (3) 8 exceed the amount specified in subsection (e)(2) of this section when combined with 9 any other scholarship received by a student based on the student's status as a child or 10 spouse of a victim of [the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks] TERRORISM. 11 (g) The Commission: 12 (1) May accept any gift or grant from any person for the Edward T. 13 Conroy Scholarship Fund; 14 (2) Shall use any gift or grant that it receives for a scholarship from the 15 Program; and Shall deposit any gift or grant that it receives for the Program with 16 (3) 17 the State Treasurer in a nonbudgeted account.
