# A BILL ENTITLED

# 1 AN ACT concerning

### **Transportation - State Highways - Roadside Solicitation**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from standing in a roadway, median divider,

- 4 or intersection of a State highway to solicit money or donations from the
- 5 occupant of a vehicle; providing that a person on whose behalf another commits
- 6 a violation of this Act is also guilty of the violation; clarifying that, in certain
- 7 counties, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection of
- 8 a county road to solicit money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle;
- 9 defining certain terms; providing certain penalties; and generally relating to the
- 10 prohibition of roadside solicitations.

### HOUSE BILL 61

1 (B) Except for the occupant of a disabled vehicle who seeks the aid of another 2 vehicle, a person may not stand in a roadway to solicit a ride, employment, or

3 business from the occupant of any vehicle.

4 [(b)] (C) A person may not stand on or near a highway to solicit any other 5 person to watch or guard any vehicle while it is parked or about to be parked on a 6 highway.

7 (D) (1) A PERSON MAY NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR
8 INTERSECTION OF A STATE HIGHWAY TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY
9 KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

# 10(2)A PERSON ON WHOSE BEHALF ANOTHER PERSON VIOLATES11PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS ALSO GUILTY OF THE VIOLATION.

[(c)] (E) In Charles County, Harford County, and Washington County, a
person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection OF A COUNTY
ROAD to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.

15 [(d)] (F) (1) In Prince George's County:

16 (i) A child under the age of 15 years may not stand in a roadway,
17 median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the
18 occupant of a vehicle; and

19(ii)An adult may not cause, encourage, allow, or petition a child20under the age of 15 years to stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to21solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.

22 (2) A child under the age of 15 years may not be found guilty or

23 adjudicated delinquent for a violation of paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection if an adult

24 caused, encouraged, allowed, or petitioned the child in violation of paragraph (1)(ii) of 25 this subsection.

# 26 (G) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF 27 A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION:

28 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$500;

29 (2) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$700; AND

30 (3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF
31 \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT LESS THAN 4 CONSECUTIVE WEEKENDS NOR
32 MORE THAN 12 CONSECUTIVE WEEKENDS OR BOTH.

33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect34 October 1, 2004.
