13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph [(3)] (2) of this subsection, each

18 board of library trustees consists of seven members appointed by the county

19 governing body from nominees submitted by the board of library trustees.

20 (2) [A board that existed before 1945 under a corporate charter may 21 continue as constituted if:

22 (i) It has at least seven members;

(ii) The members are chosen on the basis of character, ability, and
demonstrated interest in library matters; and

(iii) The members meet the qualifications required under subsection(b) of this section.

1 (3)] In Harford County, the Board of Trustees consists of at least 7 2 members, but not more than 11 members, appointed by the county governing body 3 from nominees submitted by the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 5 October 1, 2004.
