CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - School Buses - Repeal of Special Speed Limit**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a provision of law that establishes a special maximum
4 speed limit for school buses carrying passengers, thereby making school buses
5 carrying passengers subject to the vehicle speed limits otherwise applicable
6 under law; and generally relating to school bus speed limits.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

15 21-806.

16 [(a) A person may not drive a Type I school vehicle (school bus) at a speed of
17 more than 50 miles an hour while it is carrying any passenger.

18 (b) (1)] (A) On request of any local authority, the State Highway
19 Administration shall investigate and, on its own initiative, it may investigate any
20 bridge or other elevated structure that is a part of a highway.

1 [(2)] (B) If it determines that the structure cannot safely withstand the
2 weight of vehicles traveling at the maximum speed limit otherwise permitted by this
3 subtitle, the State Highway Administration shall:

4 [(i)] (1) Establish the maximum speed limit that the structure can
5 safely withstand; and

6 [(ii)] (2) At each approach to the structure, place or permit the
7 placement of a suitable sign stating the maximum speed limit.

8 [(3)] (C) A maximum speed limit established under this section is
9 effective when posted on appropriate signs giving notice of the limit.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2004.
