2 Crimes - Computers - Internet Auction Fraud

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the crime of using an Internet auction listing service
- 4 or an interactive computer service with the intent to defraud an individual of
- 5 property, services, or anything of value; providing a certain exception for the
- 6 person who provides the Internet auction listing service; providing jurisdiction
- for prosecution of the crime; requiring a person who provides the Internet
- 8 auction listing service to collect certain identification information and make this
- 9 information available to a seller or bidder who alleges fraud or deception in an
- auction transaction; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the use of
- an Internet auction listing service to obtain property by theft or fraud.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 22 INDICATED.
- 23 (2) "INTERNET AUCTION LISTING SERVICE" MEANS A WEBSITE ON THE
- 24 INTERNET OR OTHER INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE THAT IS DESIGNED TO
- 25 ALLOW OR ADVERTISED AS A MEANS OF ALLOWING USERS TO OFFER PERSONAL
- 26 PROPERTY OR SERVICES FOR SALE OR LEASE TO A PROSPECTIVE BUYER OR LESSEE
- 27 THROUGH AN ON-LINE BID SUBMISSION PROCESS USING THAT WEBSITE OR
- 28 INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE.

- 1 (3) (I) "INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE" MEANS AN INFORMATION
- 2 SERVICE, SYSTEM, OR ACCESS SOFTWARE PROVIDER THAT PROVIDES OR ENABLES
- 3 COMPUTER ACCESS BY MULTIPLE USERS TO A COMPUTER SERVER.
- 4 (II) "INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE" INCLUDES A SERVICE OR
- 5 SYSTEM THAT PROVIDES ACCESS TO THE INTERNET.
- 6 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY USE ELECTRONIC
- 7 COMMUNICATION THROUGH AN INTERNET AUCTION LISTING SERVICE OR AN
- **8 INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE:**
- 9 (1) WITH AN INTENT TO DEFRAUD AN INDIVIDUAL OF MONEY, GOODS,
- 10 SERVICES, OR ANYTHING OF VALUE; OR
- 11 (2) TO EXERT CONTROL OVER OR OBTAIN AN INDIVIDUAL'S MONEY,
- 12 GOODS, SERVICES, OR ANYTHING OF VALUE BY MEANS OF DECEPTION.
- 13 (C) (1) IF THE VALUE OF ALL MONEY, GOODS, SERVICES, AND OTHER
- 14 THINGS OF VALUE OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION EXCEEDS \$500. A
- 15 PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON CONVICTION
- 16 IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 15 YEARS OR A FINE NOT
- 17 EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.
- 18 (2) IF THE VALUE OF ALL MONEY, GOODS, SERVICES, AND OTHER
- 19 THINGS OF VALUE OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT EXCEED
- 20 \$500, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND
- 21 ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 18 MONTHS OR A
- 22 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH.
- 23 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION MAY BE PROSECUTED, INDICTED,
- 24 TRIED, AND CONVICTED IN ANY COUNTY OR STATE IN WHICH THE ELECTRONIC
- 25 COMMUNICATION ORIGINATED OR TERMINATED.
- 26 (E) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, THIS SECTION
- 27 DOES NOT APPLY TO THE PERSON WHO PROVIDES THE INTERNET AUCTION LISTING
- 28 SERVICE IF THE PERSON DOES NOT EXAMINE, SET THE PRICE, OR PREPARE THE
- 29 DESCRIPTION OF THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR SERVICE TO BE OFFERED THROUGH
- 30 THE LISTING SERVICE.
- 31 (F) A PERSON WHO PROVIDES AN INTERNET AUCTION LISTING SERVICE
- 32 SHALL:
- 33 (1) REQUIRE A SELLER OR BIDDER TO REGISTER WITH THE WEBSITE
- 34 AND PROVIDE THE SELLER'S OR BIDDER'S NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER.
- 35 AND ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS:
- 36 (2) RETAIN A SELLER'S OR BIDDER'S REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR
- 37 A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 2 YEARS;

- 1 (3) HAVE A MECHANISM TO RECEIVE COMPLAINTS OR INQUIRIES FROM 2 A SELLER OR BIDDER; AND
- 3 (4) HAVE A MECHANISM TO MAKE A SELLER'S OR BIDDER'S
- 4 REGISTRATION INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO ANOTHER SELLER OR BIDDER WHO
- 5 ALLEGES FRAUD OR DECEPTION IN AN AUCTION TRANSACTION.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 7 October 1, 2004.
