2 Electric Companies - Special Medical Equipment Program List

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring electric companies to maintain a special medical
- 4 equipment program list in accordance with regulations adopted by the Public
- 5 Service Commission; requiring electric companies to distribute the list to certain
- 6 service dispatchers to assist in restoring electricity to certain individuals under
- 7 certain circumstances; requiring electric companies to notify certain individuals
- 8 of scheduled power outages under certain circumstances; defining a certain
- 9 term; and generally relating to the special medical equipment program list.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article - Public Utility Companies

18 7-309.

- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SPECIAL MEDICAL EQUIPMENT PROGRAM LIST" MEANS
- 20 A LIST MAINTAINED BY AN ELECTRIC COMPANY OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE
- 21 SUBMITTED A CERTIFICATE BY A LICENSED PHYSICIAN THAT STATES THAT THE
- 22 INDIVIDUAL HAS A NEED FOR SPECIAL MEDICAL EQUIPMENT EITHER FOR LIFE
- 23 SUPPORT OR TO ENABLE THE INDIVIDUAL TO LIVE INDEPENDENTLY.
- 24 (B) EACH ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL CREATE AND MAINTAIN A SPECIAL
- 25 MEDICAL EQUIPMENT PROGRAM LIST IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS
- 26 ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION.
- 27 (C) EACH ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL:

- 1 (1) DISTRIBUTE ITS SPECIAL MEDICAL EQUIPMENT PROGRAM LIST TO
- 2 ITS SERVICE DISPATCHERS ON A REGIONAL BASIS FOR USE IN RESTORING
- 3 ELECTRICITY SERVICE, SO THAT INDIVIDUALS ON THE LIST MAY BE GIVEN PRIORITY
- 4 IN THE EVENT OF AN UNSCHEDULED ELECTRICITY OUTAGE; AND
- 5 (2) AT LEAST 48 HOURS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED OUTAGE, PROVIDE
- 6 NOTICE OF A SCHEDULED OUTAGE TO EACH INDIVIDUAL ON THE SPECIAL MEDICAL
- 7 EQUIPMENT PROGRAM LIST WHOSE SERVICE WILL BE AFFECTED BY THE
- 8 SCHEDULED OUTAGE.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 10 October 1, 2004.
