1 AN ACT concerning

## Vehicle Laws - Special Registration Plates - Supporting Education

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue certain

4 special registration plates designed to express support for education; specifying

5 the persons who may apply for the special registration plates and limiting the

6 classes of vehicles for which the plates may be issued; requiring an applicant for

7 the plates to pay, in addition to the annual registration fee, a fee established by

8 the Administration subject to certain requirements and limitations; providing

9 that the additional fee is not required for certain vehicles; providing for the

10 distribution of a certain portion of the fees to certain local governing bodies to be

11 used for certain educational purposes; and generally relating to the issuance of

12 special registration plates expressing support for education.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article - Transportation**

21 13-619.3.

(A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE FOR
QUALIFYING VEHICLES A SPECIALLY DESIGNED REGISTRATION PLATE EXPRESSING
SUPPORT FOR EDUCATION.

(B) THE OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER
A LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR
PARTNER OF A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT OWNS THE VEHICLE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE
BY THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR AN ORIGINAL

OR SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE VEHICLE IS
 INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:

3 (1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;

4 (2) A CLASS B (FOR HIRE) VEHICLE;

5 (3) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S RATED 6 CAPACITY OF 1 TON OR LESS;

7 (4) A CLASS E (FARM TRUCK) VEHICLE;

8 (5) A CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLE; OR

9 (6) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.

10 (C) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE
11 REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE ASSIGNED A REGISTRATION
12 PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY:

(I) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE, A
ONE-TIME FEE SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER THE ADMINISTRATION'S
COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

16 (II) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE AND EACH
17 TIME THE REGISTRATION PLATE IS RENEWED, AN ADDITIONAL FEE SET BY THE
18 ADMINISTRATION TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY IN
19 WHICH THE VEHICLE IS REGISTERED.

(2) THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY THAT RECEIVES FUNDS
DISTRIBUTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL USE THE FUNDS, IN CONSULTATION
WITH THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR, IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE BOARD OF
SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS, FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES IN A MANNER THAT
MAXIMIZES THE DIRECT EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS TO STUDENTS AND DOES NOT PAY
FOR THE SALARIES OF ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL OR TEACHERS.

26 (3) THE ADDITIONAL FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT
27 REQUIRED FOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE THAT IS EXEMPT UNDER §
28 13-903 OF THIS TITLE.

29 (4) NO PORTION OF THE FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE
30 CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE REVENUE ACCOUNT FOR
31 DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 8-403 OR § 8-404 OF THIS ARTICLE.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 July 1, 2004.
