A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of State Police - School Bus Safety Enforcement Fund -**
3 **Reporting Date**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which the Secretary of State Police is
5 required to report to the Governor and General Assembly on the status of the
6 School Bus Safety Enforcement Fund; and generally relating to the School Bus
7 Safety Enforcement Fund.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - Public Safety**

21 4-202.

22 (a) There is a School Bus Safety Enforcement Fund.

23 (b) The purpose of the Fund is to assist law enforcement agencies in
24 addressing the problem of drivers illegally failing to stop for school vehicles.

25 (c) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Fund.

1 (2) The Secretary shall receive from the Fund each fiscal year the
2 amount, not exceeding \$50,000 in a fiscal year, necessary to offset its costs in
3 administering this subtitle.

4 (d) (1) The Fund is a special, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to § 7-302
5 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

6 (2) The Treasurer shall hold the Fund separately and the Comptroller
7 shall account for the fund in conjunction with the Secretary.

8 (e) The Fund consists of:

9 (1) money credited to the Fund under § 17-106(e) of the Transportation
10 Article;

11 (2) money from any other source accepted for the benefit of the Fund;
12 and

13 (3) investment earnings of the Fund.

14 (f) The Treasurer shall invest the money of the Fund in the same manner as
15 other State money may be invested.

16 (g) Expenditures from the Fund may only be made:

17 (1) in accordance with the State budget; or

18 (2) by the budget amendment procedure as provided in § 7-209 of the
19 State Finance and Procurement Article, if at least 45 days have passed since the
20 budget amendment and supporting information were submitted to the budget
21 committees for their review and comment.

23 On or before [March 1] SEPTEMBER 1 of each year, the Secretary shall report to
24 the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General
25 Assembly on:

26 (1) the status of the Fund;

27 (2) the grants made under this subtitle;

28 (3) the costs of administering this subtitle; and

29 (4) the effect of this subtitle in reducing the problem of drivers illegally
30 failing to stop for school vehicles.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
32 October 1, 2004.
