15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 20	(a) The Board of Trustees shall reduce the pension of a retiree on ordinary disability if:
21	(1) the retiree is under normal retirement age;
	(2) the medical board certifies in a report to the Board of Trustees that the retiree is engaged in a gainful occupation paying more than the difference between:

26	(ii) the retiree's average final compensation plus \$5,000;

- 13 (c) The pension to be reduced under this section is the pension at retirement 14 without any cost-of-living adjustment.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 July 1, 2004.
