- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the sale, distribution, prescription, or dispensing of
- 4 dietary supplement products containing ephedrine group alkaloids; providing
- 5 for certain exceptions to the prohibition on the sale, distribution, prescription, or
- 6 dispensing of dietary supplement products containing ephedrine group
- 7 alkaloids; establishing certain penalties for violation of the prohibition on the
- 8 sale, distribution, prescription, or dispensing of dietary supplement products
- 9 containing ephedrine group alkaloids; defining a certain term; and generally
- relating to a prohibition on dietary supplement products containing ephedrine

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EPHEDRINE GROUP ALKALOIDS" MEANS:
- 22 (1) EPHEDRINE GROUP ALKALOIDS PRESENT IN OR EXTRACTED FROM
- 23 THE HERB EPHEDRA OR ANY OTHER HERB THAT CONTAINS EPHEDRINE GROUP
- 24 ALKALOIDS: OR
- 25 (2) SYNTHETIC EPHEDRINE GROUP ALKALOIDS.
- 26 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE
- 27 SALE, DISTRIBUTION, PRESCRIPTION, OR DISPENSING OF A DIETARY SUPPLEMENT
- 28 PRODUCT CONTAINING EPHEDRINE GROUP ALKALOIDS IS PROHIBITED.

1 (C) A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER LICENSED OR CERTIFIED UNDER (1) 2 THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE MAY PRESCRIBE OR DISPENSE A DIETARY 3 SUPPLEMENT PRODUCT CONTAINING EPHEDRINE GROUP ALKALOIDS IF THE 4 HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER: 5 IS PRACTICING WITHIN HIS OR HER SCOPE OF PRACTICE; AND (I) PRESCRIBES OR DISPENSES DIETARY SUPPLEMENT PRODUCTS 6 (II)7 CONTAINING EPHEDRINE GROUP ALKALOIDS IN THE COURSE OF THE TREATMENT 8 OF A PATIENT UNDER THE DIRECT CARE OF THE HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER. NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A (2) 10 HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER MAY NOT PRESCRIBE OR DISPENSE A DIETARY 11 SUPPLEMENT CONTAINING EPHEDRINE GROUP ALKALOIDS FOR PURPOSES OF 12 WEIGHT LOSS, BODY BUILDING, OR ATHLETIC PERFORMANCE ENHANCEMENT. 13 (D) A DIETARY SUPPLEMENT PRODUCT CONTAINING EPHEDRINE GROUP 14 ALKALOIDS MAY BE SOLD OR DISTRIBUTED DIRECTLY TO: A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER USING THE PRODUCT IN 15 (1) 16 ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION; OR A LICENSED PHARMACIST FOR SALE TO A PATIENT FOR WHOM THE 17 18 DIETARY SUPPLEMENT PRODUCT HAS BEEN PRESCRIBED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 19 SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION. 20 21-1217. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF § 21-1114 OF THIS TITLE IS GUILTY 21 22 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO: 23 FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR (1) 24 OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH; OR FOR A SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3

26 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$20,000 OR BOTH.
