BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Business Regulation** 15 10-315. All dispensing equipment for motor fuel shall be marked (1) 17 conspicuously to show: in numerals of equal size the price, including taxes, of a gallon (I) 19 of the motor fuel offered for sale; AND 20 THE COMBINED AMOUNT OF FEDERAL AND STATE MOTOR 21 FUEL TAXES PER GALLON OF MOTOR FUEL. If numerals that show a fractional cent are used, the combined height 22 23 and width of the numerator and denominator shall equal the height and width of the 24 other numerals used.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
