- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article Public Safety
- 13 5-309.
- 14 (a) A permit expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following [2]
- 15 3 years after the date the permit is issued OR ON AN EARLIER DATE DESIGNATED BY
- 16 THE SECRETARY NOT LESS THAN 2 YEARS AFTER ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT.
- 17 (b) A permit may be renewed for successive periods of 3 years each if, at the
- 18 time of an application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the
- 19 issuance of a permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 2004.
