A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Knights of St. John Hall

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 4 \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of Knights
- of St. John Hall, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 6 requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland
- 7 Historical Trust; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; prohibiting
- 8 the use of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds for religious purposes; and
- 9 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That:

- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 14 George's County Knights of St. John Hall Loan of 2004 in the total principal amount
- 15 of \$500,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 16 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 17 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 18 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 21 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 25 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 26 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 27 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Trustees of Knights of St.
- 28 John Hall, Inc. for the repair, renovation, and capital equipping of the historic
- 29 meeting hall, located in Bowie.
- 30 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 31 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and

- 1 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 2 after the date of issuance of the bonds. 3 (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey 4 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of 5 its interest: 6 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust; 7 and On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic 8 (ii) structures. 9 10 (b) If the grantee or beneficiary of the grant holds a lease on the land 11 and structures, the Trust may accept an easement on the leasehold interest. 12 (c) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust 13 and any liens or encumbrances against the land or the structures must be acceptable 14 to the Trust. 15 No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be (6) 16 used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the 17 design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of 18 sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or 19 department of divinity for any religious denomination. - 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 June 1, 2004.

20 of Public Works, the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none 21 of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a
