A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Anne Arundel County - Highways - Solicitation of Money or Donations from Occupants of Vehicles - County Licensing Program Authorized

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Anne Arundel County Council to enact, by

- 5 ordinance, a certain licensing program for individuals who are of a certain age or
- 6 older and certain organizations that wish to solicit money or donations from the
- 7 occupants of vehicles by standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection
- 8 in Anne Arundel County; providing that the licensing program, if enacted, may
- 9 impose a fee for the license in an amount not to exceed the county's cost to
- 10 administer the licensing program and may provide for an exemption for an
- 11 individual who is unable to pay the fee and any other exemption from the fee
- 12 that the county council considers appropriate or necessary; providing that if the
- county council enacts a licensing program authorized by this Act, an individualor organization that decides not to seek to become licensed under the program or
- 15 that is denied a license under the program is prohibited from standing in a
- 16 roadway, median divider, or intersection in Anne Arundel County to solicit
- 17 money or donations of any kind from the occupants of vehicles; requiring, if the
- 18 county council enacts a licensing program authorized by this Act, the Anne
- 19 Arundel County Police Department, on or before a certain date after a certain
- 20 occurrence, to report to the Anne Arundel County Delegation to the General
- 21 Assembly on certain matters; and generally relating to the solicitation of money

22 or donations from occupants of vehicles by certain individuals and organizations

23 in roadways in Anne Arundel County.

29 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

30 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Transportation

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2 21-507.

3 (a) Except for the occupant of a disabled vehicle who seeks the aid of another 4 vehicle, a person may not stand in a roadway to solicit a ride, employment, or 5 business from the occupant of any vehicle.

6 (b) A person may not stand on or near a highway to solicit any other person to 7 watch or guard any vehicle while it is parked or about to be parked on a highway.

8 (c) In Charles County, Harford County, and Washington County, a person may 9 not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of 10 any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.

11 (d) (1) In Prince George's County:

(i) A child under the age of 15 years may not stand in a roadway,
median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the
occupant of a vehicle; and

15 (ii) An adult may not cause, encourage, allow, or petition a child 16 under the age of 15 years to stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to 17 solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.

18 (2) A child under the age of 15 years may not be found guilty or 19 adjudicated delinquent for a violation of paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection if an adult 20 caused, encouraged, allowed, or petitioned the child in violation of paragraph (1)(ii) of 21 this subsection.

22 (E) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

23 (2) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "QUALIFIED ORGANIZATION" MEANS A FIRE
24 COMPANY OR A BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC, WAR VETERANS', OR
25 CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION.

(3) THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY COUNCIL MAY, BY ORDINANCE, ENACT
A LICENSING PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE 18 YEARS OLD OR OLDER AND
QUALIFIED ORGANIZATIONS THAT WISH TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS FROM
THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE BY STANDING IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR
INTERSECTION.

(4) THE RESTRICTION ON THE AGE OF INDIVIDUALS WHO MAY BE
 LICENSED UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED TO THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY
 COUNCIL UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO INDIVIDUALS
 WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE SOLICITATION OF DONATIONS AS MEMBERS OR ON
 BEHALF OF THE QUALIFIED ORGANIZATION.
