Crimes - Computers - Internet Auction Fraud <u>Theft - Use of Interactive</u> <u>Computer Service</u>

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the crime of using an Internet auction listing service

- 5 or an interactive computer service with the intent to defraud an individual of
- 6 property, services, or anything of value; providing a certain exception for the
- 7 person who provides the Internet auction listing service; providing jurisdiction
- 8 for prosecution of the crime <u>of theft by use of an interactive computer service;</u>

12 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 13 INDICATED.

(2) "INTERNET AUCTION LISTING SERVICE" MEANS A WEBSITE ON THE
 INTERNET OR OTHER INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE THAT IS DESIGNED TO
 ALLOW OR ADVERTISED AS A MEANS OF ALLOWING USERS TO OFFER PERSONAL
 PROPERTY OR SERVICES FOR SALE OR LEASE TO A PROSPECTIVE BUYER OR LESSEE
 THROUGH AN ON LINE BID SUBMISSION PROCESS USING THAT WEBSITE OR
 INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE.

(2) IF THE VALUE OF ALL MONEY, GOODS, SERVICES, AND OTHER

2 THINGS OF VALUE OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT EXCEED

3 \$500, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND

4 ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 18 MONTHS OR A

7 (D) (J) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION BY USE OF AN INTERACTIVE
8 <u>COMPUTER SERVICE</u> MAY BE PROSECUTED, INDICTED, TRIED, AND CONVICTED IN
9 ANY COUNTY OR STATE IN WHICH <u>THE VICTIM RESIDES OR</u> THE ELECTRONIC
10 COMMUNICATION ORIGINATED OR TERMINATED.

(E) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, THIS SECTION
 DOES NOT APPLY TO THE PERSON WHO PROVIDES THE INTERNET AUCTION LISTING
 SERVICE IF THE PERSON DOES NOT EXAMINE, SET THE PRICE, OR PREPARE THE

16 (F) A PERSON WHO PROVIDES AN INTERNET AUCTION LISTING SERVICE 17 SHALL:

18 (1) REQUIRE A SELLER OR BIDDER TO REGISTER WITH THE WEBSITE
 19 AND PROVIDE THE SELLER'S OR BIDDER'S NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER,
 20 AND ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS;

21 (2) RETAIN A SELLER'S OR BIDDER'S REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR 22 A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 2 YEARS;

23 (3) HAVE A MECHANISM TO RECEIVE COMPLAINTS OR INQUIRIES FROM 24 A SELLER OR BIDDER; AND

(4) HAVE A MECHANISM TO MAKE A SELLER'S OR BIDDER'S
 REGISTRATION INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO ANOTHER SELLER OR BIDDER WHO
 ALLEGES FRAUD OR DECEPTION IN AN AUCTION TRANSACTION.
