16 17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
18	Article - State Personnel and Pensions

	(a) This section applies to all employees, except temporary employees, of all units in the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative Branches of State government, including any unit with an independent personnel system.
23 24	(b) Military administrative leave may be provided to an employee subject to this section who:
25	(1) is on active military duty on July 1, 2003; or

is activated for military duty on or after July 1, 2003.

1 (c) (1) An employee who is eligible to receive military administrative leave

2 under this section is entitled to leave in an amount sufficient to compensate the

3 employee, during each pay period for which the employee is eligible to receive military

4 administrative leave under this section, for the difference between the employee's

5 active duty base salary paid by the federal government and the employee's State base 6 salary or direct wages.

7 (2) Compensation provided under this subsection may not exceed an 8 employee's State base salary or direct wages.

9 (d) An employee eligible to receive military administrative leave under this 10 section who is activated for military duty on or after July 1, 2003, shall elect to use 11 either military administrative leave or paid leave as provided in § 9-1104(3) of this 12 subtitle.

13 (e) The Department shall keep a record of the use of military administrative 14 leave under this section.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect 17 July 1, 2003. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] 2 YEARS and, at the end 18 of [June 30, 2004,] JUNE 30, 2005, with no further action required by the General 19 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 June 1, 2004.
