12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
14	Article - Health - General
15	4-217.
16 17	(c) (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, the Department shall collect a \$12 fee:
18 19	(i) For each certified or abridged copy of a birth, death, fetal death, marriage, or divorce verification certificate;
20 21	(ii) For a report that a search of the files was made and the requested record is not on file;
22 23	(iii) For each change to a certificate made later than one year after the certificate has been registered with the Department; or
24 25	(iv) To process an adoption, foreign adoption, OR legitimation [or adjudication of paternity].

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 2 effect October 1, 2004.
