

2 Lottery for Schools Act of 2004

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain lottery proceeds to
- 4 certain local school systems for a certain purpose; requiring that the local school
- 5 systems use certain lottery proceeds distributed to them for a certain purpose;
- 6 specifying that the proceeds distributed under this Act to a local school system
- 7 are intended to provide additional revenue for public education and may not
- 8 supplant other funds allocated to public education in that local school system;
- 9 providing that certain lottery proceeds be distributed to the General Fund of the
- State and used to help fund a certain statewide program for public education;
- and generally relating to the distribution of lottery proceeds to local school
- systems in the State and to the State General Fund and the use of those funds

- 3 SCHOOL SYSTEM IN THE COUNTY AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER FUNDS
- 4 ALLOCATED TO PUBLIC EDUCATION IN THE COUNTY.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
