1 AN ACT concerning

2 Natural Resources - Oysters - Dredge Devices

- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing a prohibition on a person on a dredge boat possessing or
- 4 using certain dredge devices; and generally relating to oyster dredge devices.
- 5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 6 Article Natural Resources

- 8 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 9 (2000 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article Natural Resources
- 13 4-1013.
- 14 (f) A person may not catch oysters in the waters of the State or possess any
- 15 scoop, dredge, handscrape, or similar instrument having a tooth bar more than 42
- 16 inches in length measuring from the outside teeth on dredges used in dredging on
- 17 rock bottoms or 44 inches in length measuring from the outside teeth on dredges used
- 18 in dredging on mud bottoms, or of a weight exceeding 200 pounds. [The captain or
- 19 any other person may not possess or use a "devil catcher" or "devil diver", or similar
- 20 device on any dredge boat to be attached to the dredge for steering it to the bottom.]
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 2004.
