2 Distribution of Lottery Proceeds - Public Schools

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to distribute certain lottery
- 4 proceeds to all the public school systems in the State rather than into the
- 5 General Fund of the State; requiring that public school systems use the money
- 6 that is distributed for a certain purpose; specifying that the money distributed
- 7 under this Act is intended to provide additional revenue for public school
- 8 systems and may not supplant any other appropriation to public school systems;
