- 9 (A) THE STATE BOARD DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR
- 10 THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION
- 11 YOUTH RISK BEHAVIOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM SURVEY.
- 12 (B) THE STATE BOARD DEPARTMENT MAY OMIT A SECTION OF THE SURVEY IF
- 13 THE STATE BOARD CONSIDERS THE CONTENT WITHIN THAT SECTION AS
- 14 INAPPROPRIATE UP TO A MAXIMUM OF ONE-THIRD OF THE SURVEY QUESTIONS IF
- 15 THE DEPARTMENT CONSIDERS THE CONTENT OF THE QUESTIONS INAPPROPRIATE.
- 16 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM TO
- 17 OBTAIN PARENTAL CONSENT USING A PARENTAL CONSENT FORM BEFORE

- 19 (2) THE PARENTAL CONSENT FORM SHALL INCLUDE A STATEMENT
- 20 THAT EXPLAINS HOW A PARENT CAN OBTAIN SAMPLE QUESTIONS A COPY OF THE
- 21 SURVEY QUESTIONS THAT WILL BE ADMINISTERED AND MORE INFORMATION
- 22 REGARDING THE SURVEY, INCLUDING THE MAILING ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER,
- 23 AND WEBSITE ADDRESS OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION.
