#### Vehicle Laws - <u>Interference with Operation of</u> Traffic Control <del>Signal</del> <del>Altering Devices - Prohibition</del> <u>Device or Railroad Sign or Signal -</u> Prohibitions

5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person without lawful authority from possessing

6 certain devices that are capable of transmitting certain signals to a traffic

7 control signal for the purpose of altering or interfering with the operation of the

8 traffic control signal; and generally relating to prohibiting the possession of

9 devices that alter or interfere with traffic control signals.

10 FOR the purpose of clarifying that a person without lawful authority may not

11 interfere with the operation of a traffic control device or a railroad sign or signal;

12 prohibiting a person without lawful authority from possessing, with an intent to

13 use, certain devices capable of transmitting certain signals for the purpose of

14 altering or interfering with the operation of a traffic control device or a railroad

15 <u>sign or signal; providing for a certain penalty; and generally relating to</u>

16 prohibiting a person from interfering with the operation of a traffic control

17 device or a railroad sign or signal or possessing, with an intent to use, certain

18 <u>devices under certain circumstances.</u>

# **Article - Transportation**

14 21-206.

(a) A person without lawful authority may not willfully alter, <u>OR INTERFERE</u>
<u>WITH THE OPERATION OF</u>, any traffic control device or any railroad sign or signal,
including any inscription, shield, or insignia on it.

18 (b) A person without lawful authority may not willfully deface any traffic
19 control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield, or
20 insignia on it.

21 (c) A person without lawful authority may not willfully injure any traffic
22 control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield, or
23 insignia on it.

24 (d) A person without lawful authority may not willfully knock down any traffic
25 control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield, or
26 insignia on it.

27 (e) A person without lawful authority may not willfully change the direction of
28 any traffic control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription,
29 shield, or insignia on it.

30 (f) A person without lawful authority may not willfully twist any traffic
31 control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield, or
32 insignia on it.

33 (g) A person without lawful authority may not willfully remove any part of any
34 traffic control device or any railroad sign or signal, including any inscription, shield,
35 or insignia on it.

(H) A PERSON WITHOUT LAWFUL AUTHORITY MAY NOT POSSESS, <u>WITH AN</u>
<u>INTENT TO USE</u>, ANY DEVICE CAPABLE OF TRANSMITTING AN INFRARED,
ELECTRONIC, OR OTHER SIGNAL TO A TRAFFIC CONTROL <del>SIGNAL</del> <u>DEVICE OR A</u>
