- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain registered voters to file a petition with the
- 4 circuit court that challenges the residency of certain candidates; requiring the

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Election Law
- 17 5-305.
- 18 (A) ANY REGISTERED VOTER WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE DISTRICT OR OTHER
- 19 GEOGRAPHIC AREA IN WHICH A CANDIDATE IS SEEKING OFFICE MAY FILE A
- 20 PETITION WITH THE CIRCUIT COURT THAT CHALLENGES THE CANDIDATE'S
- 21 RESIDENCY AS PROVIDED IN § 5-202 OF THIS TITLE.
- 22 (B) (1) THE PETITION SHALL BE FILED WITHIN 7 DAYS FROM THE DATE THE
- 23 CANDIDATE'S CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY IS FILED UNDER § 5-302 OF THIS
- 24 SUBTITLE.
- 25 (2) JUDICIAL REVIEW OF ANY PETITION THAT IS FILED UNDER
- 26 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE EXPEDITED BY THE CIRCUIT COURT
- 27 THAT HEARS THE CAUSE TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY IN CONSIDERATION OF THE

- $1\,$ DEADLINES ESTABLISHED BY LAW, AND IN NO CASE, LONGER THAN 7 DAYS FROM $2\,$ THE DATE THE PETITION IS FILED.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 July 1, 2004.
