2 Handguns - Identification Requirements - Repeal

- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement imposed on a handgun manufacturer
- 4 that ships or transports a handgun for sale, rental, or transfer in the State to
- 5 provide to the handgun dealer a shell casing of a projectile discharged from the
- 6 handgun and certain additional information; repealing the requirement imposed
- 7 on a handgun dealer to forward shell casings and certain information to the
- 8 Department of State Police Crime Laboratory; and generally relating to
- 9 handgun identification requirements.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article - Public Safety

- 18 [5-131.
- 19 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 20 "Manufacturer" means a person who possesses a federal license to
- 21 engage in the business of manufacturing firearms or ammunition for sale or
- 22 distribution.
- 23 "Projectile" means the part of handgun ammunition that is expelled
- 24 through the barrel of the handgun by an explosion.
- 25 "Shell casing" means the part of handgun ammunition that contains
- 26 the primer and propellent powder to discharge the projectile.

- 1 (b) A manufacturer that ships or transports a handgun for sale, rental, or 2 transfer in the State shall include in the box with the handgun in a separate, sealed 3 container:
- 4 (1) a shell casing of a projectile discharged from the handgun; and
- 5 (2) additional information that the Secretary requires to identify the 6 type of handgun and shell casing.
- 7 (c) (1) On receipt of a handgun from a manufacturer, the dealer shall 8 confirm to the Department of State Police that the manufacturer has complied with 9 subsection (b) of this section.
- 10 (2) On the sale, rental, or transfer of the handgun, the dealer shall 11 forward the sealed container to the Department of State Police Crime Laboratory.
- 12 (d) On receipt of a shell casing and information as required in subsection (b) of 13 this section, the Department of State Police Crime Laboratory shall enter the
- 14 information in each relevant database.]
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2004.
