A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Education - Full-Day Kindergarten Programs - Schools in Critical Needs or Low Socioeconomic Areas

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain county boards to provide full-day kindergarten
5 programs for kindergarten students that attend certain schools by a certain
6 school year; requiring certain county boards to provide full-day kindergarten
7 programs to all kindergarten students by a certain school year; requiring the
8 State Department of Education to make a certain determination; requiring
9 certain county boards to identify certain information in a certain plan by a
10 certain school year; requiring certain kindergarten programs to be subject to
11 certain requirements relating to certain days and hours of operation; altering
12 the effective date of a provision that would have repealed the provision of law
13 that exempts kindergarten programs from certain requirements relating to
14 minimum days or hours of operation; and generally relating to the provision of
15 full-day kindergarten programs.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article - Education**

4 7-101.

5 (e) (1) [By] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
6 BY the 2007-2008 school year, each county board shall provide full-day kindergarten
7 programs for [all] kindergarten students in that county THAT ATTEND SCHOOLS IN A
8 CRITICAL NEEDS OR LOW SOCIOECONOMIC AREA, AS DETERMINED BY THE
9 DEPARTMENT.

10 (2) BY THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL
11 PROVIDE FULL-DAY KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS FOR ALL KINDERGARTEN
12 STUDENTS IN THAT COUNTY.

13 (3) In the comprehensive master plan that is submitted under § 5-401 of
14 this [article,] ARTICLE:

15 (I) [a] A county board REQUIRED TO PROVIDE FULL-DAY
16 KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS BY THE 2007-2008 SCHOOL YEAR UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)
17 OF THIS SUBSECTION shall identify the strategies that will be used in that county to
18 ensure that full-day kindergarten programs are provided to [all] kindergarten
19 students in that county by the 2007-2008 school year; AND

20 (II) A COUNTY BOARD REQUIRED TO PROVIDE FULL-DAY
21 KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS BY THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)
22 OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL IDENTIFY THE STRATEGIES THAT WILL BE USED IN
23 THAT COUNTY TO ENSURE THAT FULL-DAY KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS ARE
24 PROVIDED TO ALL KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS IN THAT COUNTY BY THE 2011-2012
25 SCHOOL YEAR.

27 (G) (1) BEGINNING IN 2007, KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS IN SCHOOLS
28 IDENTIFIED UNDER § 7-101(E)(1) OF THIS TITLE ARE SUBJECT TO THE
29 REQUIREMENTS OF § 7-103(A) OF THIS TITLE RELATING TO MINIMUM DAYS OR
30 HOURS OF OPERATION.

31 (2) BEGINNING IN 2011, KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS IN SCHOOLS
32 IDENTIFIED UNDER § 7-101(E)(2) OF THIS TITLE ARE SUBJECT TO THE
33 REQUIREMENTS OF § 7-103(A) OF THIS TITLE RELATING TO MINIMUM DAYS OR
34 HOURS OF OPERATION.

35 **Chapter 288 of the Acts of 2002**

36 SECTION 25. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 3 of this Act
37 shall take effect July 1, [2007] 2004.
