- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain licensing requirements for palm readers,
- 4 fortune-tellers, soothsayers, and other similar persons in Cecil County; and
- 5 generally relating to the licensing of palm readers, fortune-tellers, soothsayers,

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

- Notwithstanding any other sections of the Business Regulation Article, in Cecil
- 17 County any palm reader, fortune-teller, soothsayer, or similar person shall apply to
- 18 the Board of County Commissioners of Cecil County for a license to carry on business.
- 19 The license shall be issued by the County Commissioners only upon proof that the
- 20 person has been a resident, taxpayer, and property owner of Cecil County for at least
- 21 18 months prior to the application for the license. The annual fee for the license shall
- 22 be \$250 and the license shall be issued by the clerk of the Circuit Court of Cecil
- 23 County and may be revoked by the Board for good cause.]
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 2004.
