2 **Cecil County - Palm Readers, Fortune-Tellers, and Soothsayers - Licensing**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain licensing requirements for palm readers,
4 fortune-tellers, soothsayers, and other similar persons in Cecil County; and
5 generally relating to the licensing of palm readers, fortune-tellers, soothsayers,
6 or similar persons in Cecil County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions**

15 [11-401.

16 Notwithstanding any other sections of the Business Regulation Article, in Cecil
17 County any palm reader, fortune-teller, soothsayer, or similar person shall apply to
18 the Board of County Commissioners of Cecil County for a license to carry on business.
19 The license shall be issued by the County Commissioners only upon proof that the
20 person has been a resident, taxpayer, and property owner of Cecil County for at least
21 18 months prior to the application for the license. The annual fee for the license shall
22 be \$250 and the license shall be issued by the clerk of the Circuit Court of Cecil
23 County and may be revoked by the Board for good cause.]

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2004.
