BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 4 9-102. 5 IN ALLEGANY COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND (b-3)(1) 6 LIGHT WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED, EXCEPT BY 7 WAY OF RENEWAL. IN GARRETT COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND LIGHT 30 31 WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED, EXCEPT BY WAY 32 OF RENEWAL, TO A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY 33 HOLDING AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IN ANY OTHER STATE OR IN 34 WASHINGTON, D.C. 35 [(6)](8) In Washington County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light 36 wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to 37 a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages 38 license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October <u>July</u> 1, 2004.
