(7) IN GARRETT COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND LIGHT
 WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED, EXCEPT BY WAY
 OF RENEWAL, TO A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

22 [(6)] (8) In Washington County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light 23 wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to 24 a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages

25 license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.
