SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17

18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20	SUBTITLE 8. HUMAN CLONING PROHIBITION ACT.

Article - Criminal Law

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 22 (A) 23 INDICATED.

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(B) "HUMAN CLONING" MEANS HUMAN ASEXUAL REPRODUCTION
 ACCOMPLISHED BY INTRODUCING THE NUCLEAR MATERIAL OF ONE OR MORE
 HUMAN SOMATIC CELLS INTO A FERTILIZED OR UNFERTILIZED OOCYTE WHOSE
 NUCLEUS HAS BEEN OR WILL BE REMOVED OR INACTIVATED TO PRODUCE A LIVING
 ORGANISM AT ANY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT WITH A HUMAN OR PREDOMINANTLY
 HUMAN GENETIC CONSTITUTION.

7 (C) "HUMAN SOMATIC CELL" MEANS A DIPLOID CELL OBTAINED OR DERIVED8 FROM A LIVING OR DECEASED HUMAN BODY AT ANY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT.

9 (D) "NUCLEAR TRANSPLANTATION" MEANS TRANSFERRING THE NUCLEUS OF
10 A HUMAN SOMATIC CELL INTO AN OOCYTE FROM WHICH THE NUCLEUS OR ALL
11 CHROMOSOMES HAVE BEEN OR WILL BE REMOVED OR RENDERED INERT.

12 (E) "NUCLEUS" MEANS THE CELL STRUCTURE THAT HOUSES THE 13 CHROMOSOMES.

16 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT:

17 (1) PERFORM OR ATTEMPT TO PERFORM HUMAN CLONING;

18 (2) PARTICIPATE IN AN ATTEMPT TO PERFORM HUMAN CLONING;

19 (3) TRANSFER OR RECEIVE THE PRODUCT OF HUMAN CLONING; OR

20 (4) TRANSFER OR RECEIVE, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, ANY OOCYTE, 21 EMBRYO, FETUS, OR HUMAN SOMATIC CELL FOR THE PURPOSE OF HUMAN CLONING.

(B) (1) THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO RESTRICT A PERSON
FROM CONDUCTING OR ATTEMPTING TO CONDUCT SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH NOT
SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITED BY THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) A PERSON MAY CONDUCT OR ATTEMPT TO CONDUCT SCIENTIFIC
 RESEARCH THAT USES NUCLEAR TRANSFER OR OTHER CLONING TECHNIQUES TO
 PRODUCE:

- 28 (I) MOLECULES;
- 29 (II) DNA;

30 (III) CELLS OTHER THAN HUMAN EMBRYOS;

- 31 (IV) TISSUES;
- 32 (V) ORGANS;
- 33 (VI) PLANTS; OR

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1 (VII) ANIMALS OTHER THAN HUMANS.

3 (A) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON
4 CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR A FINE
5 NOT EXCEEDING \$100,000 OR BOTH.

6 (B) (1) THE SECRETARY MAY ASSESS A CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST ANY
7 PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE OF NOT LESS THAN \$1,000,000 OR THE
8 APPLICABLE AMOUNT UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, WHICHEVER IS
9 GREATER.

IF THE VIOLATOR DERIVES PECUNIARY GAIN FROM THE
 TRANSACTION, THE SECRETARY MAY ASSESS A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN
 TWO TIMES THE GROSS PECUNIARY GAIN RESULTING FROM THE VIOLATION.

13 (C) THE CIVIL PENALTIES ASSESSED AGAINST A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS14 SUBTITLE SHALL BE PAID TO THE GENERAL FUND.

15 (D) IF ANY PERSON FAILS TO PAY ANY PENALTY ASSESSED UNDER THIS
16 SECTION, A CIVIL ACTION FOR RECOVERY OF THE PENALTY MAY BE BROUGHT BY
17 THE STATE AGAINST THE PERSON.

18 (E) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO GIVE A PERSON A PRIVATE 19 RIGHT OF ACTION.

20 (F) A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GROUNDS FOR THE DENIAL OF AN
21 APPLICATION FOR, DENIAL OF RENEWAL OF, OR REVOCATION OF ANY LICENSE,
22 PERMIT, CERTIFICATION, OR ANY OTHER FORM OF PERMISSION REQUIRED TO
23 PRACTICE OR ENGAGE IN ANY TRADE, OCCUPATION, OR PROFESSION REGULATED BY
24 THE STATE.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2004.

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
